Scholarships are awarded and selected based upon completed application and transcripts and includes criteria such as character, merit, and community service. Scholarships can be used for either part-time or full-time attendance. No recipient shall be eligible for an award more than two years.

Scholarship receipts are selected by the Tom Owens Memorial Scholarship Fund committee and funds available through generous donations and fundraisers.
